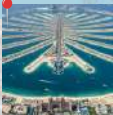
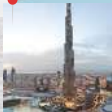

Payment Terms:

- 20% Tour Cost - Booking deposit per person (if booked 60 days or above)
- 50% Tour Cost - 45-31 days prior to departure.
- 100% Tour Cost - 30 days prior to departure.
- All prices are based on a minimum number of person traveling together.
- Any changes in the number of participants may result in an increase in the price



Conditions:

- All passengers must travel together on the outbound journey.
- The Package Cost given to you is subject to minimum Passengers travelling together, if the Number of Travelling Passengers reduced the Package cost will vary and will Increase.
- The quotation is subject to change for reasons beyond our control like change in hotel tariffs, increase in transportation cost, impact of hike in fuel charge, & any changes in local taxes etc.
- All Passengers should travel in Group and no deviations are permitted.
- Room is based on Twin sharing basis
- Any Increase in the rate of exchange leading to an increase in all land arrangements which may come in to effect prior to departure.

FAQ's

Q1. Do I need a visa to visit Dubai (UAE)?

- Indian Citizens: Yes, you need a UAE Tourist Visa.
- Options: 48-hour, 96-hour, 14-day, 30-day, or 90-day visa
- Apply through UAE airlines (Emirates, Etihad), approved agents, or online portals.
- Visa on Arrival is available for Indian citizens with a valid US, UK, Schengen visa or residence permit.

Q2. What documents are required?

- Valid passport (minimum 6 months validity)
- Confirmed return flight ticket
- UAE visa or visa-on-arrival eligibility proof
- Hotel booking confirmation
- Travel insurance (recommended)

Q3. How long does the visa process take?

- Usually 3–5 working days.
- Express processing available in 24–48 hours at additional cost.



FAQ's

Q4. What is the currency in Dubai?

- UAE Dirham (AED)
- ₹1 = ~0.045 AED
- 1 AED = ~₹22.5 (approx.)

Q5. Can I use my credit/debit cards?

- Yes, widely accepted everywhere.
- Carry some cash (AED) for taxis, markets, and tips.

Q6. Where can I exchange currency?

- At the airport, malls, or licensed money changers.
- Avoid unlicensed exchanges.

Q7. What are the transportation options?

- Metro – Clean, fast, and budget-friendly
- Taxis – Safe and regulated (flag down or book via Careem/Uber)
- Buses and trams – Affordable options



FAQ's

Q8. Indian/vegetarian food available?

- Yes, plenty of Indian and vegetarian restaurants.
- Vegan and Jain food also available in select places.

Q9. Is street food safe?

- Generally safe, but stick to well-reviewed outlets.

Q10. Can I drink alcohol in Dubai?

- Only in licensed bars, hotels, and clubs.
- Public drinking is strictly prohibited.

Q11. Should I buy a local SIM card?

- Yes. Tourist SIMs with data are available at Dubai Airport.
- Providers: Etisalat, du, Virgin Mobile
- Requires passport for activation

Q12. Is Wi-Fi available?

- Widely available in hotels, malls, airports, and cafes.

- Dubai Mall, Mall of the Emirates, Ibn Battuta Mall
- Gold Souk, Spice Souk, Karama Market for souvenirs
