Q1. Do I need a visa to visit Singapore and Malaysia?

- Singapore: Yes, apply for a tourist visa in advance (Online or via an agent).
- Malaysia: Yes, apply for an eVisa or eNTRI before travel.

Q2. What is the best time to visit?

- Singapore: Year-round, but March to August is drier.
- Malaysia: December to April (west coast like Kuala Lumpur, Langkawi), May to September (east coast like Perhentian Islands).

Q3. What documents should I carry?

- Passport (valid for at least 6 months)
- Singapore & Malaysia visa printouts
- Hotel bookings & flight tickets
- Travel insurance (recommended)
- Emergency contact numbers

Q4. Do I need travel insurance?

- Not mandatory, but highly recommended for medical emergencies, trip delays, and loss of belongings.

Q5. What currencies are used?

- Singapore: Singapore Dollar (SGD)
- Malaysia: Malaysian Ringgit (MYR)

Q6. Can I use international cards?

- Yes, Visa/Mastercard are widely accepted.
- Carry some cash for local markets, taxis, or street food.

- MRT (Metro) – Clean, safe, efficient
- EZ-Link Card – For buses & MRT
- Taxis, Grab app (ride-sharing)

Q8. How do I get around Malaysia?

- Grab app is very popular
- Buses and intercity trains are also available.

Q9. What types of accommodations are available?

- Budget hostels to 5-star hotels
- Airbnbs are available in both countries
- Book early, especially for peak seasons or festivals

Q10. Is vegetarian food available?

- Yes, both countries have Indian restaurants and vegetarian options.
- Try Little India (Singapore) & Brickfields (Kuala Lumpur).

Q11. Is street food safe?

- Generally safe in both countries.
- Drink bottled water, avoid raw/uncooked street food.

Q12. Should I buy a local SIM card?

- Yes, cheap tourist SIMs are available at the airport or city.
- Singapore: StarHub, Singtel, M1
- Malaysia: Digi, Maxis, Celcom
